

## PGE Capacity Reservation Application for Medium Commercial Qualifying Systems (>10 to ≤100 kW)

**PGE will notify the Customer that an application is complete and whether the proposed system has been awarded a reservation via this RFP for the volumetric incentive rate bidding option of the Oregon feed-in tariff pilot program. The required deposit becomes nonrefundable once the system has been awarded a reservation. Within two (2) months from the date of reservation notification (the “capacity reservation start date”), Customer must submit an Application for Interconnection or lose the reservation. Within twelve (12) months of the date of reservation notification (the “capacity reservation start date”), System must be built and have passed final Authority Holding Jurisdiction electrical inspection.**

Currently, OAR 860-084-0195(3) requires a capacity reservation deposit of \$20 per kW of the proposed system size. The proposed rule OAR 860-084-0195(5) in Docket No. AR 558 requires a deposit of \$500 or \$20 kW, whichever is larger. If this proposed rule is adopted before the bid option enrollment window closes, participants who systems sizes are 25 kW or smaller will be required to submit the balance of the deposit.
